Sabbath Streams is a ministry of teaching and encouragement focused on understanding from the perspective of grace – the richness and depth of life found in the law of G-d, through practical observances of the Moedim (appointed times and seasons), the practice of a Davidic worship as led by Ruach HaKodesh (Holy Spirit), and teachings and guided discussions centered on the full Word of G-d, the Tanach (Old Covenant Scriptures) and the Apostolic Writings (New Covenant Scriptures) with an emphasis on the place of the home in spiritual development.
